POSITION SUMMARY:	Part-time, non-benefited position for the Wayfinders Program with California State University, Fresno Foundation. The position is year round. The Academic Student Coach (ASC) reports to the Academic Coordinator. The ASC will be part of the Wayfinders Peer Mentorship Program and will support Wayfinders students in their academic studies. The ASC will support the integration of Wayfinders students on the campus. The ASC advocates for, facilitates, and supports the Wayfinders students in their academic efforts. Applicant must have a strong interest in improving the lives of individuals with disabilities. Assignments will rotate as needed for proper staffing of student activities, projects and due dates. Shift work: morning, evening, and/or weekend hours.
