<p>POSITION & SUMMARY:</p>	<p>Full-time, 12 month position through the California State University, Fresno Foundation. The Educational Talent Search Program serves high school, low-income and first-generation college bound students. The program assists students to continue, and graduate from secondary school and to enroll in postsecondary educational programs through extensive academic counseling, career/major orientation and exploration, tutorial assistance and a variety of other intensive services. Schools served are Tulare Union, Tulare Western, Redwood, Riverdale, Mendota and Firebaugh High Schools. This position will be housed at Fresno State.</p>
<p>ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:</p>	<p>Under the supervision of the Program Director, the incumbent will be responsible for the following operations. Typical duties include, but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Preparation and implementation of advising and counseling services to approximately 340 students at the target schools and to work closely with school site counselors and staff • Collecting and pre-screening student applications for program eligibility • Submitting students applications recommendations to the Program Director • Assessing students educational needs • Assisting students with the implementation of their Individual Student Educational Plan (ISEP), college admission test- prep, college admissions, financial aid application, and scholarship and career exploration • Providing workshops, seminars, assisting in the implementation of early outreach activities • Participating in in-service training needed to ensure successful implementation of assigned duties as related to the accomplishment of program objectives • Maintaining records of students for case management purposes • Assisting the Project Director in the preparation of reports, surveys, and other documents necessary for the continued funding and successful operation of the program • Other duties as assigned
