MAJOR DUTIES:	<p>The Behavior Interventionist (BI) will provide direct behavioral support to clients, collect data, implement behavior change plans as outlined by his/her supervising Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA), and take direction from graduate student supervisors. Typical duties include, but are not limited to, the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist in communication between families/caregivers, graduate student supervisors, BCBAs, and administrative staff • Conduct preference assessments and run clinical programs as directed by supervisors • Assist supervisors and BCBAs with conducting functional behavior assessments • Data collection • Follow behavior protocols • Create and maintain a positive environment for our clients while reinforcing desirable behaviors • Use incidental teaching strategies • Update the supervisors and BCBAs of changes in the client’s behaviors • Behave professionally and ethically when representing FBS in client homes, in the community, and on campus • Other duties as assigned
